3 ways to write the same thesis:

- 1. No one is anyone else's master, and no one is anyone else's slave.
 - a. Philosophy Speak: You do not have the ability to tell anyone else how to choose their preferences and nobody has the right to tell you how to choose your preferences.
 - b. What is this about political theories?
- 2. Other men's lives are not yours to dispose of.
 - a. Should we force other people to pay for opera productions?
 - i. Seizing someone's earnings = plunder
 - b. If I have to pay for opera, I should be able to make others pay for what I want too.
 - c. Beware inventors of utopias they will treat others as slaves to achieve their vision
 - d. But other men's lives are not yours to dispose of
- 3. No human being should be a nonvoluntary mortgage on the life of another.
 - a. I cannot claim your life, your work, or the products of your effort as mine.
 - i. I am not your master.
 - ii. The theft of your money by a robber is not justified by the fact that he used it to help his injure
 - iii. Each human being has the right to live his life as he chooses compatibly with the equal right of all other human beings to live their lives as they choose.
 - iv. Man has the right to life, liberty, and property!
 - v. Depriving you of your property is depriving you of the means by which you live.
